BOOKING INFORMATION

On the phone or in person

Telephone lines are open during Box Office hours or call into the venue.

Tickets can be purchased with credit/debit cards or cash. A 50p per ticket administration fee will be charged (up to a maximum payment of £3). Please note that this fee applies to all bookings made via telephone or in person.

Online

Tickets can be booked online up to the day of the event. A transaction fee of £2 will apply.

Concessions

Where applicable concession tickets are offered, but ages vary and are set by the hirer.

Please note that not all events offer concession options.

Carers

Tickets are offered free of charge at most events, you will need to advise the Box Office at the time of booking as a ticket is required.

Babes in Arms

Children under the age of two must have a free 'Babes in Arms' ticket for licensing requirements. Children over the age of two must have a paid ticket issued at the relevant price.

Exchange or refund of tickets

Programme information is correct at the time of going to print, but is subject to change. Patrons are advised to check their tickets at the time of booking as tickets and fees are not refundable. Subject to availability and return of original tickets, we can exchange tickets for another performance of the same production and a £2 administration fee will be charged for this service. Where the new performance is at a higher cost, the price difference will be charged, but if lower, we would not be able to provide a refund.

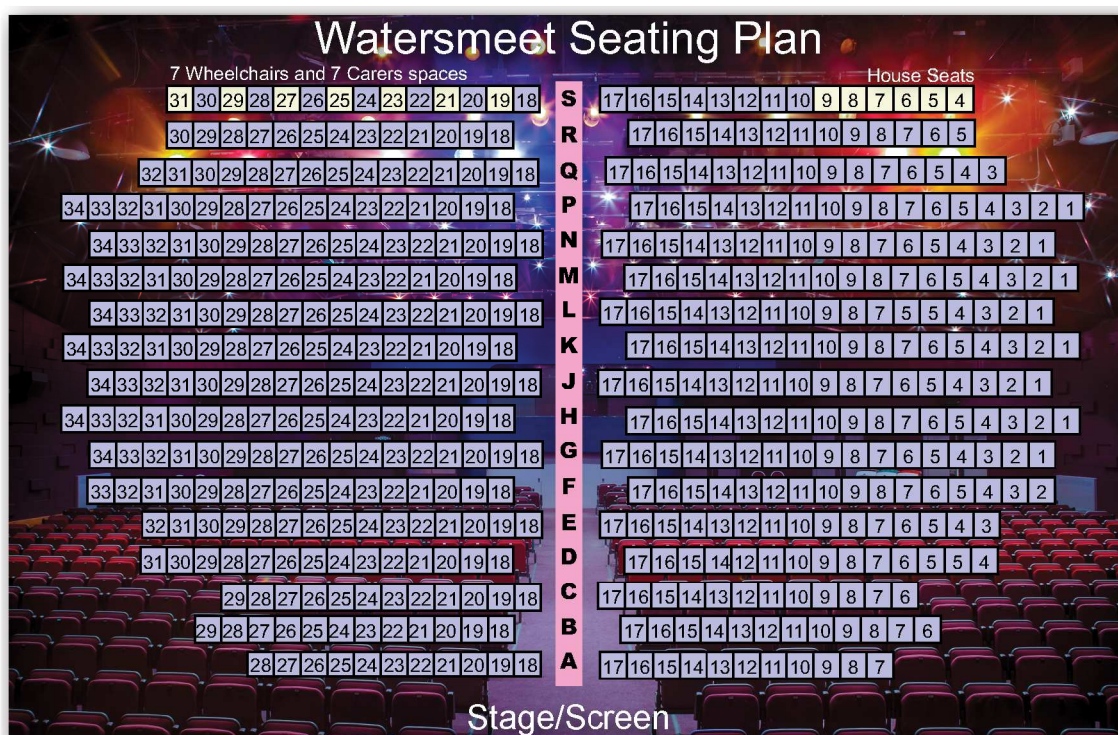

The Box Office is also open 1 hour before curtain up on performance days and will remain open for 15 minutes after the start of the show.

As a venue for hire the price of the tickets is passed back to the hirer. The booking fee is a charge to cover our administration, overheads, staffing costs and applicable credit card fees.



YOUR VISIT

Disabled access and facilities

Watersmeet is fully accessible and offers the following facilities:

- Lift from the lower to the upper foyer
- Disabled toilet
- Emergency exit for wheelchair users
- Disabled ramp to the side of the stage
- Reserved seating situated in the rear of the Auditorium
- Hearing loop

When booking your tickets, please ensure you advise the Box Office if you require assistance or you are a wheelchair user.

Finding us

Watersmeet is situated in the centre of Rickmansworth, on the High Street and is easily reached by rail or road. Rickmansworth Station is a short walk away and is served by both the Metropolitan and Chiltern line trains.

Parking

Free off street parking is available for up to 2 hours and there are several car parks in the town centre offering 2 hours of free parking during the day (these are clearly signposted as you enter the town).

After 6.30pm parking is not limited to 2 hours, however we suggest that you check applicable charges. If you intend to stay more than 2 hours, there are long term car parks available at Talbot Road, Rickmansworth Station car park (Waitrose) and at the Long Island Exchange. Charges apply and spaces are subject to availability.

Car parking vouchers for some events can be purchased via the Watersmeet Box Office for £1 and allow you to park in any of the 2 hour public car parks for 4 hours.

For weekend and evening performances only, Watersmeet recommends parking in the Three Rivers House staff car park. Parking for the duration of the show is allowed in these bays. For any further assistance please call the Box Office on 01923 711063 during opening hours.

Staff Car Park: Three Rivers House, Northway, Rickmansworth, WD3 1RL (after 6.30pm and weekends only).

Please note: The lower section of the staff car park closes at 11pm and Watersmeet staff are unable to assist if you get locked in.
